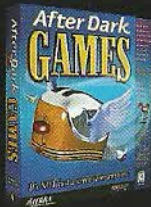


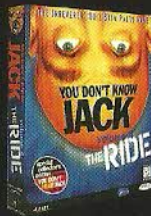

AFTER DARK for WINDOWS QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

After Dark is the award-winning popular screen saver from Berkeley Systems. A screen saver is a fun way to protect your screen from the shadowy images that can appear when the same motionless display sits on your screen too long and screen phosphor is destroyed. This problem is called burn-in. After your computer has been inactive for a set period of time, After Dark presents a screen-saving display.

This Quick Reference Guide contains all the information you need to install After Dark and get familiar with its features. However, if you need more help with specific features or operations, just access the online help located within After Dark. For information concerning general Windows operation, please consult your computer's User's Guide.

INSTALLING AFTER DARK

A Typical install puts all of After Dark's necessary files in their proper locations and updates any other Berkeley Systems screen savers you own. Remember to turn off any other screen savers and all anti-virus programs before you install. To install After Dark, follow these step-by-step instructions.

Place the After Dark CD into your CD-ROM drive. Click the Start button in the Windows 95 taskbar and select Run. In the Command line box, type `d:\setup` (where `d:` is the letter of your CD-ROM drive). Select OK. A Setup Wizard will guide you through the installation. When the Choose a Destination box appears, select OK to install to the suggested default directory. Click the Browse button to install After Dark to a different directory. In the Setup Options box, select Typical Install to ensure all files are properly installed. Select Custom if you only want to install selected components of After Dark. Follow the on-screen instructions.

This version of After Dark replaces older versions of the After Dark control panel that you have installed on your computer. If you own other Berkeley Systems screen saver packages, Displays from those packages will be put into individual folders within the After Dark Files folder. Those folders appear as options in the After Dark Control Panel.

TERMS TO KNOW

After Dark Display

An individual screen-saving Display, such as Starry Night or Flying Toasters.

After Dark Control Panel

The window that lets you run After Dark Displays and change their settings.

After Dark Icon

A very small blue and yellow picture of an After Dark screen, which appears in the notification section of the Windows 95 taskbar, just to the left of the clock. You can click this button to open the After Dark Control Panel.

Tree View of Displays

The list of screen saver Displays that appears in the list box on the After Dark Control Panel. The Displays are organized in a tree format, grouped within product folders for each Berkeley Systems screen-saver product.

Randomizer

A feature that lets you choose any number of Displays that will be shown in random order when your After Dark screen saver is activated. You can also set how long you want each Display to run.

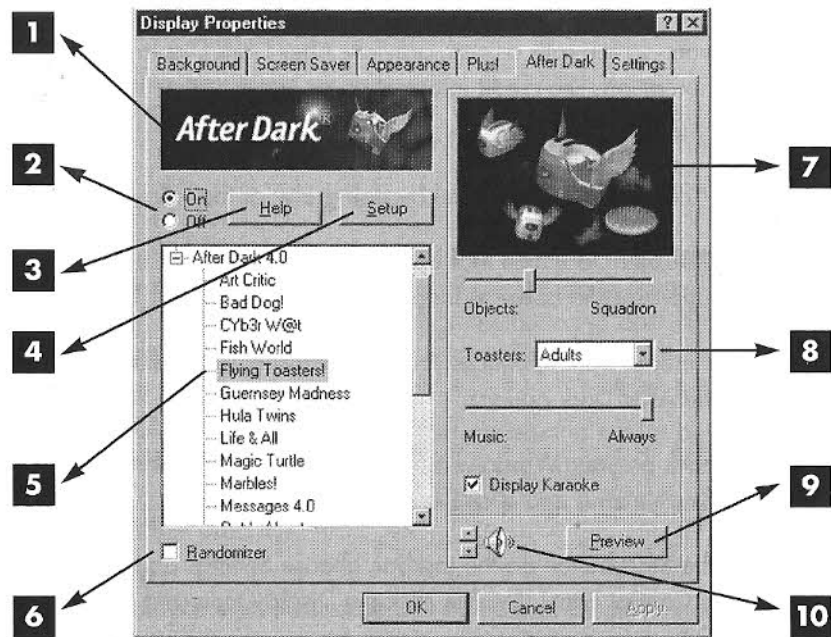
AFTER DARK CONTROL PANEL

The After Dark Control Panel allows you to choose which Display will run when your screen falls asleep, preview After Dark Displays, turn After Dark on or off, see credit information or select further setup options.

Open the After Dark Control Panel by doing any of the following:

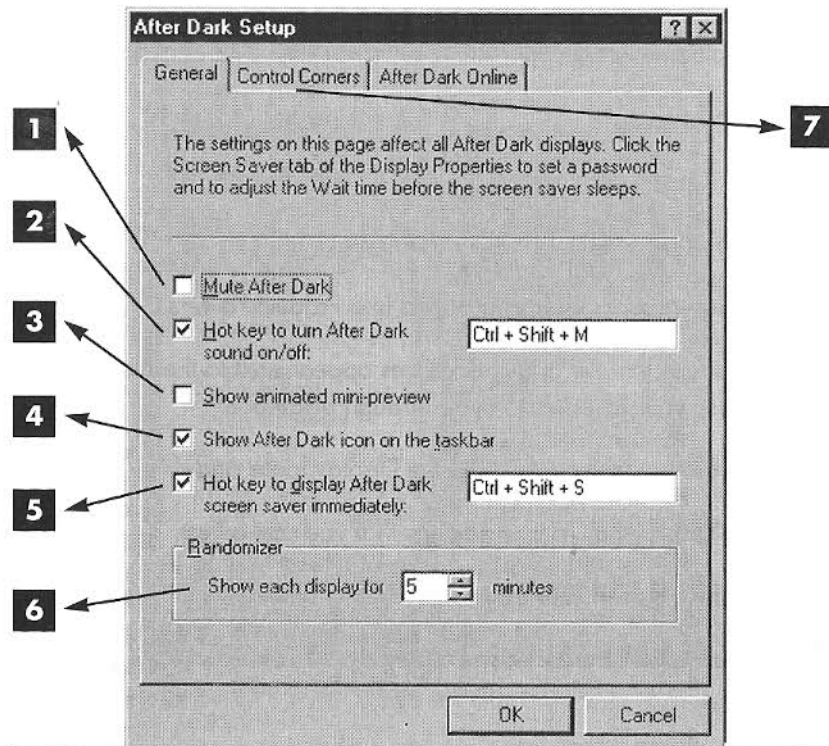
- Click the After Dark Icon that appears next to the clock in the notification section of the Windows 95 taskbar.
- Click the Start button, choose Programs, and choose After Dark from the After Dark options.
- Right-click on your Windows 95 desktop, choose Properties from the pop-up menu, and click the After Dark tab.
- Click the Start button on the taskbar, choose Settings and then choose Control Panel. Double-click the Display icon and click the After Dark tab.

AFTER DARK CONTROL PANEL



- 1 Faceplate - click on it for the credits and other information.
- 2 On/off switch
- 3 Help is just a click away!
- 4 Setup adjusts other After Dark settings.
- 5 Tree view list of Displays grouped into Product Folders.
- 6 Select Randomizer and checkboxes appear next to the displays. Choose your favorites to cycle through at random
- 7 Mini-preview shows you how the Display looks and runs.
- 8 Each Display has its own settings that you can adjust.
- 9 Get a full-screen preview of the selected Display.
- 10 Adjust the volume for each Display.

AFTER DARK SETUP



- 1 Select if you want to prevent After Dark from playing music or sound in all Displays.
- 2 Sound can be turned on or off instantly by a hot key. To change the default key, click in the text box and type a new letter. The Control-Shift key combination is automatically inserted.
- 3 Check to show an animated version of mini-preview.
- 4 Click to place a check mark if you want the After Dark Icon to appear next to the clock in the notification section of the Windows 95 taskbar.
- 5 The screen saver can be activated instantly by using a three-key combination. To change the default key, click in the text box and type a new letter. The Control-Shift key combination is automatically inserted.
- 6 Adjust the duration of displays included in Randomizer with the small arrow buttons or by clicking in the box and typing a number.
- 7 Click this tab to set up Control Corners to control how and when After Dark activates its screen saving displays.

INSTALLING AFTER DARK

Prior to installing, turn off all anti-virus programs and quit all applications. If you do not know how to turn off the virus protection software, refer to its Help file or User's Manual. Avoid conflicts by removing screen savers not made by Berkeley Systems from your System Folder.

Place the After Dark CD-ROM in a CD-ROM drive. Double-click on the "Double-Click Me to Install" icon. A screen appears with information about this screen saver collection. Select Continue. The Install screen appears. Select the type of installation you want.

Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed with installation. When installation is complete, the installer prompts you to restart your system. Don't forget to fill out your registration card and send it in.

After installation, After Dark is in the Control Panels folder. The installer also puts an alias to After Dark in your Apple menu. To access After Dark, either select After Dark from the Apple menu, or select Control Panels from the Apple menu, then open After Dark.

TERMS TO KNOW

After Dark Control Panel

The program that gives you control of After Dark, its configuration, its displays, and its Sleeptime.

After Dark Files

Where you will find all displays and support files.

After Dark Display

An individual screen saver, such as Hula Twins or Flying Toasters.

Product Folder

Any folder inside the After Dark Files folder that contains at least one display.

Sleep

After Dark senses when your Macintosh has been inactive for a pre-set amount of time and presents a screen-saving display.

Idle

Idle time is when no input is received from either keyboard or mouse and there hasn't been any other activity on your computer.

THE AFTER DARK CONTROL PANEL

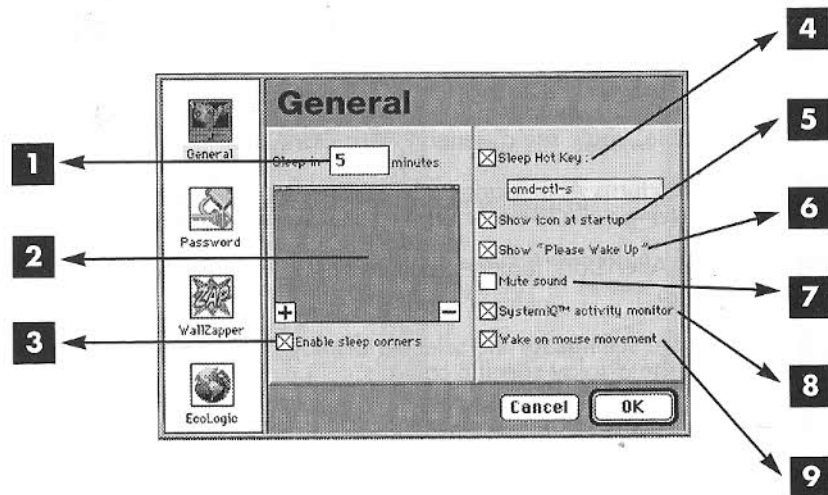
The After Dark Control Panel allows you to choose which display will appear when your screen falls asleep, change a display's settings, or see help information. You can also configure After Dark's by clicking the Setup button.

THE AFTER DARK CONTROL PANEL



- 1** To see credits, version information and other information, click on the logo faceplate.
- 2** By clicking on the down arrow, the Product Folder pop-up menu is displayed so that you can choose which screen saver package to use.
- 3** Click on a display's name to select it. The currently selected display's name is highlighted.
- 4** This graphic is a thumbnail of the selected display. If one is unavailable, you'll see a generic After Dark icon.
- 5** This switch turns After Dark off or on. If After Dark is turned off, screen saving will not occur until After Dark is turned on again.
- 6** To set up After Dark features such as Password and EcoLogic, click Setup.
- 7** Change the settings for the selected display in the Control Panel by using the display-specific controls.
- 8** Click the arrows of the speaker icon to turn the volume up or down for the selected display.
- 9** The Demo button lets you preview the currently selected display and change settings while it's running.
- 10** To see more information on a display and its controls, click on the text at the bottom of the Control Panel.

AFTER DARK SETUP



- 1 Type a number in the box to set how many minutes your computer must be Idle before After Dark goes to sleep.
- 2 Drag the + and - boxes to your Sleep corners. The + box marks the Sleep Now corner. The - box marks the Never Sleep corner.
- 3 Select to enable the Sleep Corners feature.
- 4 Select to turn on the Sleep Hot Key feature, allowing you to put After Dark to sleep with the key combination. To change the default key, click in the text box and type a new letter
- 5 Check this box to make After Dark Display its icon during startup.
- 6 Check this box to have After Dark Display a message when another program needs your attention.
- 7 Select if you want to prevent After Dark from playing sound or music in all Displays.
- 8 Check this box to keep your screen awake during system activity (such as background print jobs). Deselect this box if After Dark does not come on at set time or the displays are moving slowly and jerkily.
- 9 The Demo button lets you preview the currently selected display and change settings while it's running.

OTHER SPECIAL SETUP FEATURES



Password

Password allows you to change After Dark's security features. After Dark can protect your system with a password you choose. When After Dark sleeps with password protection on, you can access your system only if you type in the correct password.



WallZapper

WallZapper enables you to turn your favorite screen saver display into desktop art! Just press Command-Control-Z while the display is running.



EcoLogic

EcoLogic is After Dark's power manager, reducing your computer's power consumption in three stages: running a regular After Dark Display; powering off your monitor; and shutting off your computer.

RANDOMIZER

Can't decide which display to use? Don't worry. With Randomizer, you can use all your favorite displays. Just select your favorites and Randomizer will display them in order or randomly. You can also decide how long each display is presented.

HOW TO RANDOMIZE

To create your first Randomizer setting, select Randomizers from the Product Folder pop-up menu. Select Randomizer from the list of Randomizers and click New.

Select a Product Folder from the pop-up menu. Use this menu to select displays from different sets. Double-click the displays you want in your Randomizer or click once and then click Add -->. You can select the same display more than once to make it appear more frequently than others. Click the Select All button to select all the displays in a folder. Click the Add-> button to add them all.

The list of displays shows you the order in which the displays will appear if you choose In Order from the Randomizer display controls.

Click Remove to remove a highlighted display from the list above. Use the Up and Down buttons to move a display up or down the list, changing the order of the displays. Use the display controls to adjust the settings for the selected display. The settings apply only within this Randomizer.

Click Demo to preview the currently selected display. The speaker icon controls sound for the currently selected display. However, the speaker icon on the Randomizer control determines the maximum volume for all displays.

Use the slider to control how long each display appears. If Default is selected, the display will appear for the default duration chosen in the Randomizer display controls.

Type in a unique name for your Randomizer creation. It will show up in the display list whenever you select Randomizer from the Product Folder pop-up menu.
